## Dear Parents & Students,

Warm greetings and hearty congratulations to you and your ward on securing admission into the MBBS Course at Government Medical College, Mumbai.

The Government Medical College will be run at Gokuldas Tejpal (G.T.) The eligibility criteria for the final university examination as per internal assessment and attendance is also available on the college website at https://gmcmumbai.org/.

Students of Government Medical College, Mumbai are expected to display a high degree of personal integrity and character at all times during your course in this institution. The undergraduate programme is a full-time course and it often entails working beyond college and hospital working hours.

- 2. As we are a tertiary care hospital with an attached Super-specialty hospital, the college and hospital has made adequate arrangement to cater to any staff or student falling ill. Hopefully, you are vaccinated for Hepatitis B.
- If you require hostel facilities please contact <u>Dr. Rupali Pawar</u>; 9967599330 for Girls hostel and <u>Dr. Vivek Karad</u>; 9604937240 for Boy's Hostel. Strictly adhere to the regulations of the hostel at all times. Violation of regulation may lead to disciplinary action/expulsion from the hostel.
- Maintain cordial relation with all concerned at your place of study and pay adequate compliments to all faculty and seniors ad required from time to time.
- 5. This institution observes zero tolerance for issues pertaining to ragging and gender discrimination for which appropriate cells are functioning.
